- Supply us with the number of students and adults attending plus age of the students.
- Tell us what you would like the students to take away from the experience.
- Are there any particular topic the students would like more information on e.g. eucalypts.
- Native flavoured icecreams can be arranged for students at an additional cost.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR COST:

\$6.00 per student

Parking for buses is available onsite.

Please be prepared when visiting our garden, as this creates an enjoyable experience!

OUR RECOMMENDATIONS:

- > The best time of the year to visit is between **May and November**.
- > **July to September** is usually the optimum flowering period and the weather is great for walking around the garden.
- > Heat can be a disadvantage for students and it can detract from the experience.
- > We recommend 32 degrees and above is a little too warm.
- > If rain occurs we can use our Conference Room and show a DVD on the garden and talk to the students about arid plants and the arid community.
- > We recommend booking at least two months in advance to fit into our booking systems. Our tour guides are volunteers and the tour's rely on their availability.
